A holder of the professional certificate of a Beauty Make-Up Artist, level I:

- Is able to work in a sustainable manner regarding the health of the customer and the environment
- Is able to service a customer in his/her mother tongue and one foreign language
- Is able to communicate in a positive way with the customers, colleagues and employers
- Has knowledge and is able to use the knowledge of facial anatomy and physiology, skin diseases and skin hygiene, substance chemistry, colour theory and lighting theory, history of make-up, fashion trends in make-up
- Is able to prepare an analysis of face and use this knowledge for the creation of personalised make-up
- Is able to make an analysis of the colour type and use this knowledge for the creation of personalised make-up
- Knows and is proficient in the techniques of application of beauty make-up products
- Is able to colour eyebrows and eyelashes with permanent colours
- Is able to tidy-up and finish hair arrangements
- Is able to apply make-up styles depending on the personality of the customer and the objective of make-up
- Is able to sell and present make-up products
- Is able to work according to occupational health and safety and fire safety requirements, provide basic first aid, understand the rights and obligations of an employee
- Is able to perform beauty make-up in accordance with a given sketch and to calculate the quantities of required make-up products

The objectives of the Professions Chamber include establishment and development of an integrated and organised professional qualifications system, establishment of prerequisites for achieving comparability of the qualifications of Estonian employees and acknowledgement of other countries, as well as management of the state register of professions as the authorised processor.</p>
