A holder of the Gardener I professional qualification certificate:

- knows the structure and development stages of plants
- knows the materials (fruit and berry cultivated species; diseases of horticultural plants; pests, etc)
- knows how to propagate and graft plants
- knows practical gardening (soil preparation; seed gathering and storage; seed preparation for sowing and sowing as such; planting, mixed soil preparation, fertilisation and plant protection works according to instructions, watering, the use and maintenance of watering and irrigation systems, weeding, thinning, mulching, supporting, tying up, labelling, cutting and designing plants according to instructions; harvesting; crop initial processing and preservation; preparing plants for wintering; winter monitoring; etc)
- is able to use horticultural machinery (lawnmower, trimmer, hedge trimmer, rotary cultivator, etc)
- is able to perform the maintenance of horticultural equipment and knows its operating techniques
- is able to set up paths, lawn, etc and maintain these all the year round
- is able to perform simple construction works
- is able to make undecorated wreath rings and garlands

A level I gardener usually works together with the supervisor.
