- knows the financial matters of the company, agricultural crediting and support measures (loans, leases, funds, direct aid)
- knows the accounting principles of the company and taxes
- knows and is able to use technological machinery and equipment
- is able to designate objects on a plan and to map them on a plan
- knows the varieties of greenhouses and storage facilities

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE ⁽¹⁾

A holder of the Gardener III professional qualification certificate is employed in gardens, planted areas, gardening farms, cemeteries, nurseries, as horticultural caregivers in greenhouses and in other fields of the floral trade.
