- support and develop impaired capacity for locomotion or action of patients of different ages and with special needs
- give physiotherapeutic advice and consultation
- cooperate with other members of the rehabilitation team
- follow the requirements for professional ethics

The objectives of the Estonian Qualification Authority lie in facilitating the establishment and development of an integrated and organised professional qualifications system, establishing prerequisites for achieving comparability of the qualifications of Estonian employees as well as acknowledgement of other countries, and managing the state register of professions as an authorised processor of the register.</p>
