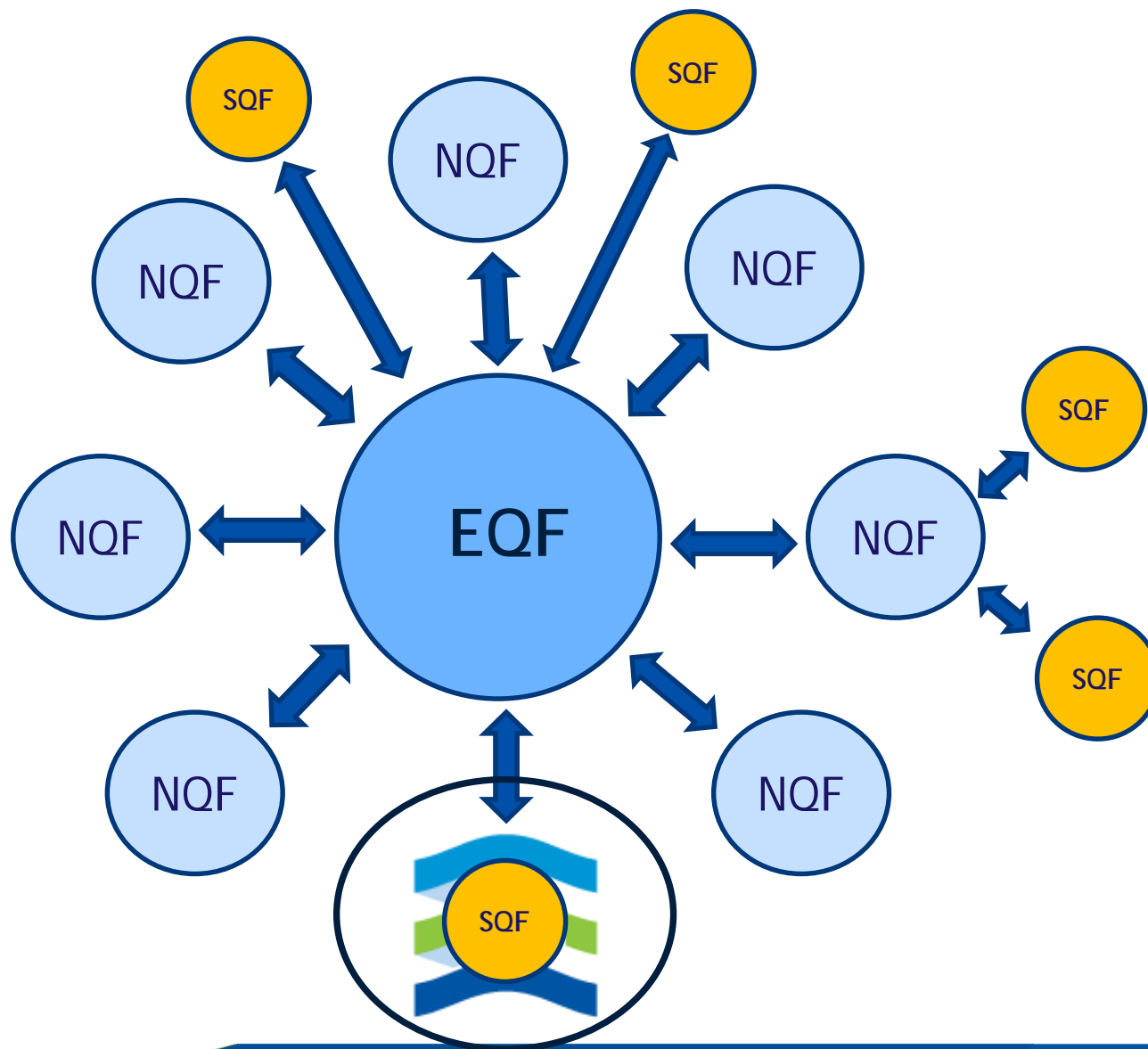
European Agency for the Management of Operational Cooperation at the External Borders of the Member States of the European Union

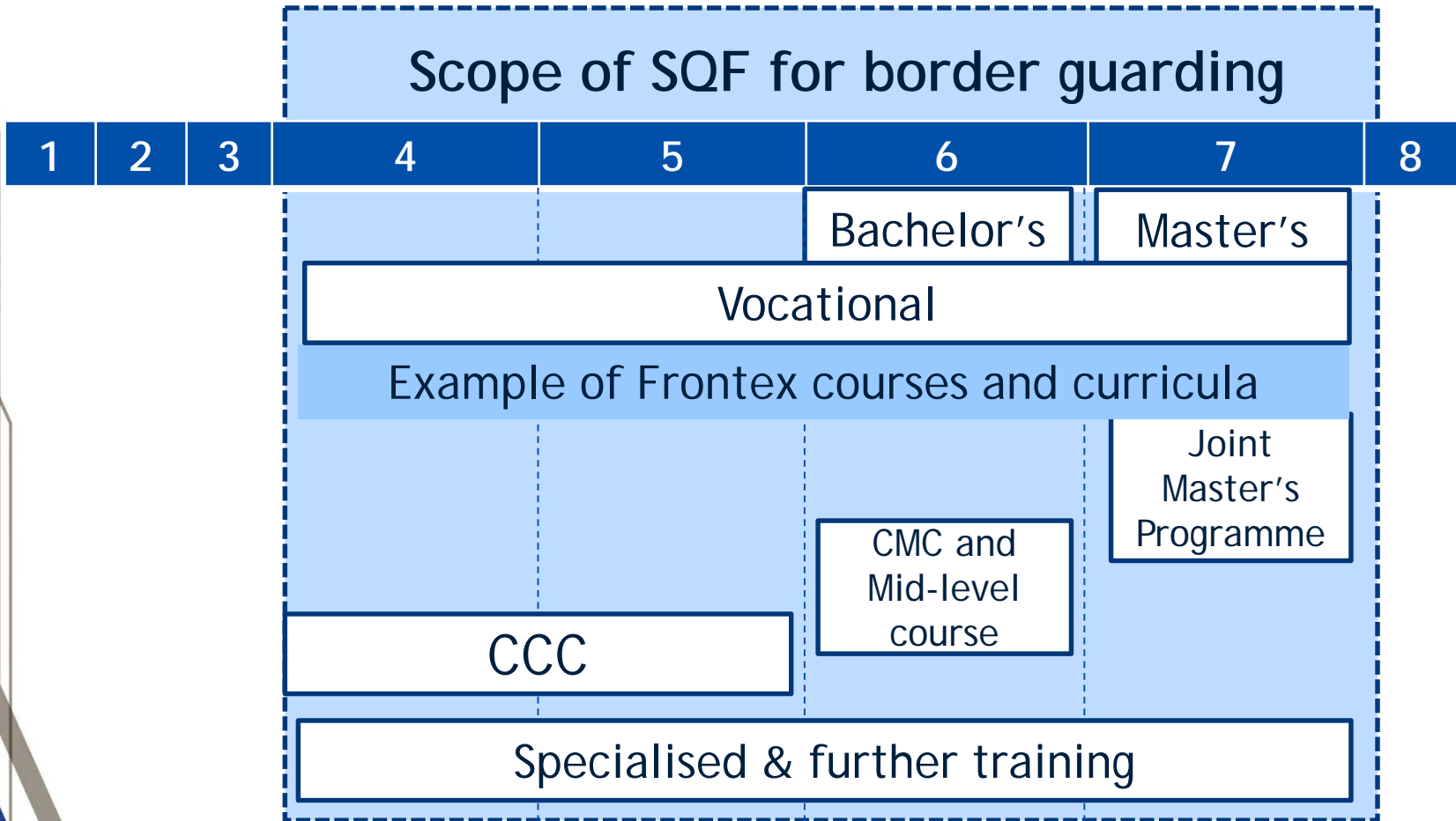

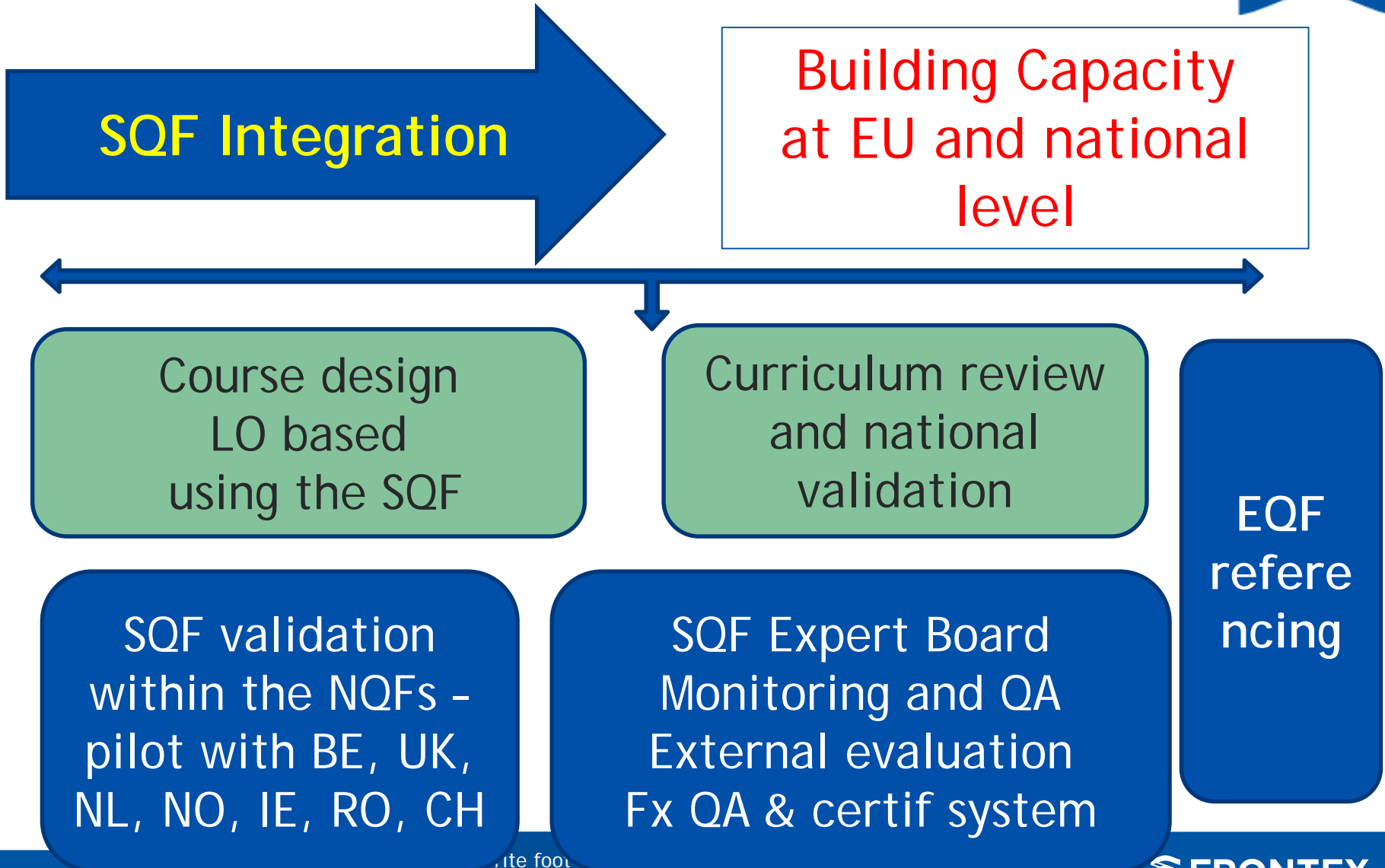

SQF usage

- Review of job competence profiles and occupational standards (**EBGT, UK, FR, NL, EE, RO** etc)
- Review, validation and/or reaccreditation of training programmes (**FI, EE, FR, RO, NL, PL, ES - LV - LT, IT**)
- Develop compatible courses through European partnerships for exchange and mobility (**DE - MT - AU - EE - SW, BE, EJMSBM** etc)
- Design operationally relevant courses based on the SQF
- Common understanding, shared language for border learning and qualifications
- RPL
- Facilitate the integration of Frontex common core curricula
- Integration of fundamental rights principles into all border guard learning
- Development of national (organisational) sectoral frameworks and official recognition of the profession (**PL, NL, EDA, EFCGA NET**)
- Effective strategic management of training and resources

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
