

OCCUPATIONAL STANDARD Logger, level 2

The occupational standard is a document that describes the job and the competence requirements, i.e asset of skills, knowledge and attitudes, required for successful performance of work.

The occupational standard of a logger, of level 2, serves as a basis for preparing study programmes of vocational training and in-service training and assessing the competency of persons when awarding occupational qualifications.

On the basis of this occupational standard, both initial occupational qualification and occupational qualification will be awarded:

- a) initial occupational qualification will be awarded when fulfilling a nationally recognised curriculum meeting this occupational standard. A remark concerning awarding initial occupational qualification recorded in the graduation certificate/an annex to the diploma shall confirm that the person has received preparation and possesses readiness to start working in the profession at the respective level.
- b) occupational qualification will be awarded if the body awarding the occupational qualification has assessed the conformity of the competencies confirmed in the actual working life of the person with the occupational standard and issued an occupational qualification.

Part A JOB DESCRIPTION

A.1 Job description

A logger, of level 2, is a skilled worker who performs simpler cutting work according to the work tasks given. One works mainly on the cuttings of routes: rides, the edges of roads, ditches, line passages etc. A logger uses and maintains clearing saws and chain saws. A logger works safely and ergonomically and maintains one's safety equipment and any other equipment required for work operable.

A.2 Units

A.2.1 Work with clearing saws and chain saws

- 1) Choosing a tool
- 2) Assessment of risk factors and the planning of work
- 3) Choosing and use of safety and work equipment
- 4) Maintaining safety and work equipment
- 5) Maintenance of a clearing saw and chain saw
- 6) Work with a clearing saw
- 7) Work with a chain saw

8) Action in the case of an accident

A.3 Work environment and features

A logger works outside, in an environment of vibration and noise. The job is more harmful than average and requires physical stamina and working in forced positions. A logger shall use respective safety and work equipment and adhere to occupational safety requirements. One is in contact with exhaust gases in one's job.

A.4 Tools

The main work equipment of a logger is clering saws and chain saws, the safety and work equipment required in cutting.

A.5 Personal characteristics necessary for this job: abilities and personality

The occupational qualification assumes concentration, fast reaction and physical stamina.

A.6 Most common official titles

Logger, saw operator, saw man

A.7 Vocational training

Usually the initial occupational qualification of a logger, level 2, will be awarded upon passing a vocational study programme in a vocational educational institution. The occupational skills may be obtained during actual work too.

In order to be awarded the occupational qualification of a logger, level 2, certifying competency B.2.1 shall be required.
